3. വെളുത്തുള്ളി അരച്ചത് - 1 ടീസ്പൂൺ
4. സവാള അരച്ചത് - 1 എണ്ണം
5. മുളകുപൊടി - 1/2 ടീസ്പൂൺ
6. മഞ്ഞൾപൊടി - 1/4 ടീസ്പൂൺ
7. ഏലയ്ക്ക ചതച്ചത് - 1 എണ്ണം
8. ഗ്രാമ്പൂ - 6 എണ്ണം
9. വെളിച്ചെണ്ണ - 1/4 കപ്പ്

പാകം ചെയ്യുന്ന വിധം

എണ്ണ ചൂടാകുമ്പോൾ ഗ്രാമ്പൂവും ഏലയ്ക്കായും ഇടുക. മുത്ത മണം വരുമ്പോൾ മുളക് അരച്ചതിട്ട് വഴറ്റണം. മുളകിന്റെ നിറം മാറിത്തുടങ്ങുമ്പോൾ വെളുത്തുള്ളി അരച്ചത്, ഇഞ്ചി അരച്ചത്, മഞ്ഞൾപൊടി, മുളകുപൊടി, ഉപ്പ് എന്നിവ ചേർത്ത് വീണ്ടും വഴറ്റി മുപ്പിക്കണം. 1 കപ്പ് വെള്ളം, 2 ടേബിൾ സ്പൂൺ പുളി വെള്ളം, റൊമാറ്റോ സോസ് എന്നിവ ഇതിലൊഴിച്ച് തിളപ്പിക്കണം. പാകത്തിന് ഉപ്പും ചേർക്കണം. അതിനുശേഷം തിള വന്നു കഴിഞ്ഞാൽ മീൻ കഷണങ്ങൾ ഈ അരപ്പിൽ നിരത്തി പാത്രം അടച്ചിട്ട് വേവിക്കണം. ഒടുവിൽ വെള്ളംവറ്റി അരപ്പ് മീനിൽ പൊതിഞ്ഞ് എണ്ണ തെളിയുന്ന പാകത്തിന് പാത്രം അടുപ്പിൽനിന്നു വാങ്ങണം.
