Worship enables one to identify one's own nature.

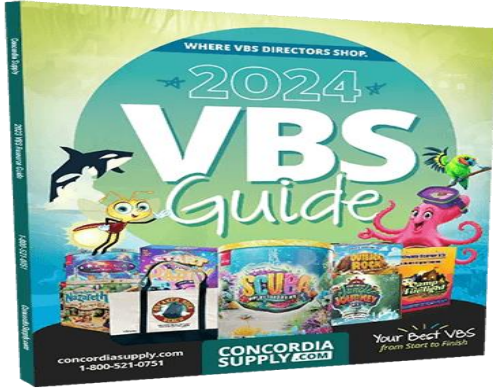
